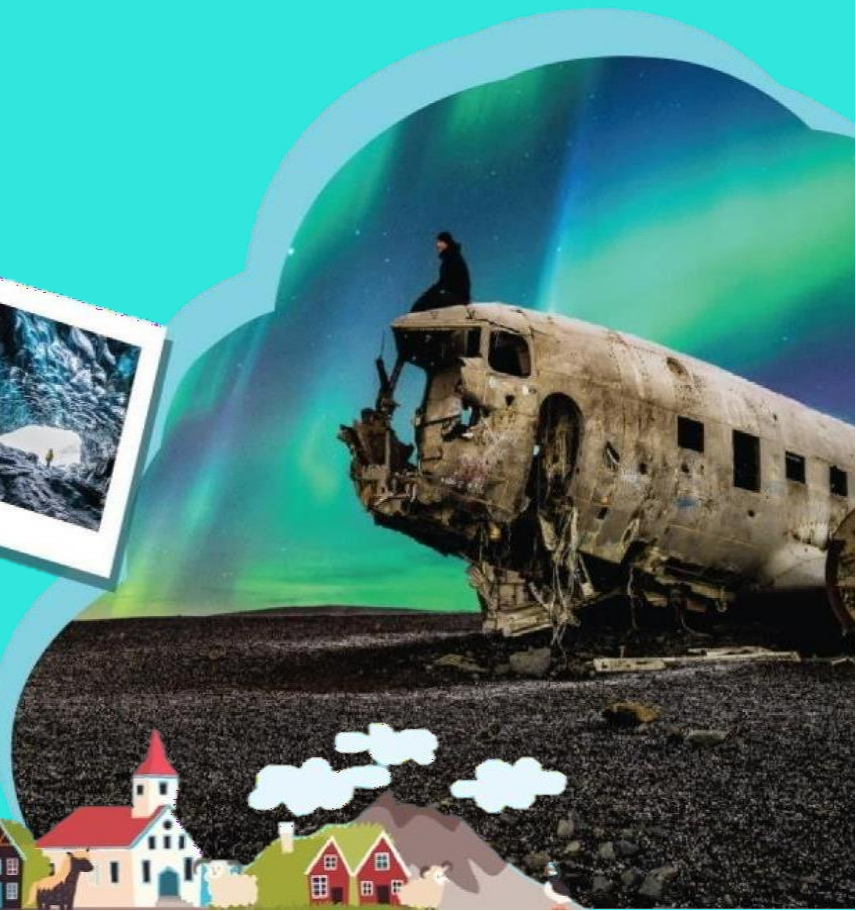

# DAY-WISE ITINERARY

DAY 1: DELHI – HELSINKI	MEAL ON BOARD – INDIAN DINNER
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Greetings from **GO**everywhere Holidays!!

We gladly introduce ourselves as the one stop provider for all your travel needs and requirements. Your presence at the Indira Gandhi International Airport 3 hours prior to the departure is mandatory. Our experienced Tour Manager will meet you at Delhi airport and assist you with all the formalities before boarding the flight early in the morning from Delhi to Helsinki.

Upon arrival at Helsinki in the afternoon, proceed for a city tour of Helsinki including Sibelius Monument, St. Nicholas Church, Senate Square and Helsinki Library.

Later, have dinner in the evening in an Indian restaurant followed by an overnight stay in the hotel at Helsinki.

DAY 2: HELSINKI – REYKJAVIK	PACKED BREAKFAST – INDIAN DINNER
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Today packed breakfast will be served. Later, proceed to Helsinki airport to board the flight to Keflavik.

As you leave behind the charming Nordic capital, the journey continues toward a land known for its dramatic landscapes and natural wonders. Upon arrival at **Keflavik International Airport**, the gateway to Iceland, you will complete the arrival formalities before stepping into the breathtaking environment often referred to as the **“Land of Fire and Ice.”**

From the airport, the adventure begins with the famous **Golden Circle tour**, one of Iceland’s most popular sightseeing routes that showcases some of the country’s most spectacular natural attractions. The first stop is **Thingvellir National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for both its geological and historical significance. This remarkable location sits in a rift valley between the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates, making it a rare place where you can literally witness the Earth’s continents slowly drifting apart. The park is also deeply connected to Icelandic heritage, as it was the site where the world’s oldest parliament was established in the year 930. Surrounded by lava fields, clear streams, and dramatic cliffs, the area offers a truly unique and memorable experience.

The journey then continues to the geothermal area of **Strokkur**, one of the country’s most active geysers. Here you will witness the fascinating power of nature as boiling water erupts high into the air every few minutes, creating an impressive spectacle that attracts visitors from all over the world. The bubbling hot springs and steaming landscape make the entire area feel almost otherworldly.

Next, the tour proceeds to the magnificent **Gullfoss**, often described as one of Iceland’s most beautiful waterfalls. The powerful cascade plunges into a rugged canyon in two dramatic tiers, creating a mesmerising display of mist, roaring water, and stunning views. On sunny days, the mist rising from the waterfall often forms rainbows, making the scenery even more magical.

After an exciting day exploring Iceland’s iconic natural wonders, the journey continues to the vibrant capital city of **Reykjavik**. Here, you will enjoy a city tour that introduces you to the unique charm of this northern capital, known for its colourful houses, modern architecture, and lively cultural atmosphere. As evening approaches, a delicious Indian dinner awaits, offering a comforting taste of home after a day of adventure. The day concludes with a relaxing overnight stay in Reykjavik, preparing you for more unforgettable experiences in Iceland.

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, the day begins with check-out and departure for a scenic journey through the northern landscapes of Iceland. The route leads towards the beautiful **Skagafjörður Valley**, a region famous for its wide open fields, dramatic mountains, and strong connection to Icelandic heritage. Here, a brief stop is made for photographs with the iconic Icelandic horses grazing peacefully in the surrounding pastures. The powerful horseshoe-shaped waterfall creates a mesmerising sight as the water plunges dramatically into the river below, surrounded by rugged volcanic landscapes.

Continuing the journey, the tour proceeds toward the captivating Lake Mývatn region, a place renowned for its extraordinary volcanic scenery and unique ecosystems. The area is filled with lava formations, geothermal activity, and serene natural beauty that make it one of Iceland's most fascinating regions.

Here, you will explore the mystical **Dimmuborgir Lava Field**, often called the "Dark Castles." This surreal landscape is made up of towering lava pillars, caves, and unusual rock formations created by ancient volcanic eruptions. Walking through this area feels almost otherworldly, with dramatic shapes and shadows that spark the imagination.

The adventure continues with a visit to the geothermal wonderland of **Námaskarð Geothermal Area**. Here, the earth seems alive with bubbling mud pools, steaming vents, and colourful mineral deposits painting the ground in shades of orange, yellow, and red. The strong scent of sulfur and the rising steam create a truly dramatic and unforgettable landscape.

A brief stop is also made near the relaxing Mývatn Nature Baths area, often referred to as the "Blue Lagoon of the North." Although entry is not included, visitors can admire the serene surroundings and observe the milky blue geothermal waters that make this spot so famous.

After a full day of exploring Iceland's incredible natural beauty, the journey continues back to the charming northern town of Akureyri. Upon arrival, enjoy a delightful three-course local dinner featuring authentic Icelandic flavors, offering the perfect opportunity to relax and reflect on the day's unforgettable experiences. The evening concludes with a comfortable overnight stay in Akureyri, preparing you for another exciting day of discovery in the land of fire and ice.



After enjoying a hearty breakfast at the hotel in Akureyri, it is time to check out and begin another scenic day of exploration in Iceland. The journey continues through breathtaking landscapes as you travel towards some of the country's most fascinating natural attractions. The drive itself is a memorable experience, with views of rugged mountains, lava fields, and picturesque countryside that showcase the raw beauty of Iceland.

The first stop of the day is **Barnafoss**, a striking waterfall known for its powerful currents and unique rock formations. The name Barnafoss translates to "Children's Falls," and it carries a touching local legend that has been passed down through generations. The rushing glacial water carves its way dramatically through narrow lava channels, creating an impressive display of nature's force and beauty. Visitors often pause here to admire the turquoise waters and the fascinating geological features that surround the falls.

After spending time at Barnafoss, the journey continues to the nearby **Hraunfossar Waterfalls**, one of Iceland's most unusual and enchanting natural wonders. Unlike traditional waterfalls that cascade from a river, Hraunfossar consists of countless small streams of crystal-clear water that gently emerge from beneath a vast lava field and flow into the Hvítá River. The water appears to seep magically through the porous volcanic rock, creating a series of delicate cascades that stretch across a wide distance. The tranquil atmosphere and the stunning contrast between the dark lava formations and the bright blue water make this spot incredibly picturesque and peaceful.

Following these unforgettable experiences, the journey continues toward the charming town of **Borgarnes**, located along the scenic Borgarfjörður fjord. Upon arrival, guests will check in to the hotel and have some time to relax and unwind after a day filled with natural wonders and scenic travel.

In the evening, a delightful three-course local dinner will be served at the hotel. This meal offers an opportunity to savor authentic Icelandic flavors while enjoying the warm hospitality and cozy atmosphere of the hotel. After dinner, guests can relax and reflect on the day's experiences before settling in for a comfortable overnight stay in Borgarnes, preparing for more adventures in the beautiful land of fire and ice.

After enjoying a hearty breakfast, the day's journey begins with a scenic drive toward the charming region of Husafell, located in the heart of Iceland's breathtaking natural landscape. Surrounded by lava fields, glaciers, and rugged highlands, Husafell serves as the gateway to one of the country's most thrilling and unique experiences. From here, you will embark on the unforgettable adventure known as **"Into the Glacier."**

This extraordinary excursion takes you deep inside the mighty Langjökull Glacier, the second-largest glacier in Iceland. The journey begins with an exciting ride on a specially designed **Monster Truck**, built to navigate the icy terrain of the glacier. As the massive vehicle climbs across the vast white expanse, you will witness stunning panoramic views of Iceland's untouched wilderness, creating an unforgettable sense of adventure. The drive itself is a thrilling experience, allowing you to appreciate the immense scale and beauty of the glacier.

Upon reaching the entrance to the glacier tunnel, you will step inside the magnificent **ice cave** carved directly into the glacier. Walking through the sparkling blue and white corridors of ice feels like entering another world. The guide will explain the fascinating formation of glaciers, their structure, and the important role they play in Iceland's natural environment. The translucent ice walls, illuminated by soft lighting, reveal stunning layers of frozen history formed over centuries. This glacier walk offers a rare opportunity to safely explore the heart of an ancient ice cap and truly understand the wonders of nature.

After this incredible experience within the Langjökull Glacier, the journey continues as you travel south through Iceland's dramatic landscapes toward the picturesque village of **Vík**, located along the country's famous south coast. The route offers mesmerizing views of volcanic terrain, black sand plains, waterfalls, and distant mountains, making the drive itself a memorable part of the day.

Upon arrival in Vík, check in to the hotel and take some time to relax after the day's adventures. In the evening, enjoy a delightful **three-course local dinner** served at the hotel, offering a taste of authentic Icelandic cuisine prepared with fresh regional ingredients. Surrounded by the peaceful atmosphere of this coastal village, the day concludes with a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel in Vík, allowing you to unwind and prepare for more remarkable experiences in the days ahead.



After breakfast, start our tour to Iceland's magnificent south coast with its beautiful waterfalls, fabulous black sand beaches and view of majestic glaciers.

We will continue our journey along the southern coast of Iceland to the world-famous black sand beach of Iceland – **REYNISFJARA**. Upon visiting the beach, you will immediately observe rocky sea stacks sitting off the shoreline, known as Reynisdrangar.



Next, we proceed towards the famous **Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon** where blue, white, turquoise and black streaked icebergs shift and creak about in an icy dance. The icebergs are 1,000-year-old chunks of the retreating Oraefajökull glacier that have broken off and are floating out to sea. Enormous icebergs constantly break off the glacier into the lagoon, melting slowly as they drift towards the sea nearby.

Return to the hotel at VIK, have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay.



## DAY 8: VIK - REYKJAVIK

BREAKFAST – INDIAN DINNER

After breakfast, journey through a breath-taking landscape to visit one of the most stunning waterfalls in Iceland – **Skógafoss**. Skógafoss is one of the biggest waterfalls in Iceland, with a drop of some 60 meters and a width of 25 meters. A legend is connected to Skógafoss waterfall; it is believed that behind it you can find a chest filled with gold and treasures. The story goes that Þrasi Þórólfsson, the Viking Settler at Skógar in around 900, hid the chest and it is said that the first man who goes there will find great treasures.

Next, visit **Seljalandsfoss**, which is a beautiful waterfall along the southern coast. It cascades over steepcliffs, which makes it possible for you to walk behind the waterfall. You will get a spectacular view of the waterfall itself and the surroundings.



It is in Reynisfjara Black Beach, Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss that the famous song "Gerua" from the film "Dilwale" starring Shahrukh Khan and Kajol was shot.

Next, proceed towards the south coast of Iceland at **Sólheimasandur** which is a sand desert formed by jökulhlaup, or glacial outburst floods, from the Katla volcano system that lies underneath the Mýrdalsjökull glacier.

In 1973, a DC-3 US Navy plane ran out of fuel and landed on the beach of Sólheimasandur. Everyone survived the landing. The plane wreck is still there and it has become a popular site.

Next, journey from the eastern to the western part of Iceland through a breath-taking landscape. After a scenic ride for about two hours, reach Grundarfjordur's beautiful landmark, **Kirkjufell (Church Mountain)** which is said to be the most photographed mountain in Iceland. Its isolated position, 463 meters above sea level and jutting out into the sea, makes it a focal point for travellers and locals alike.

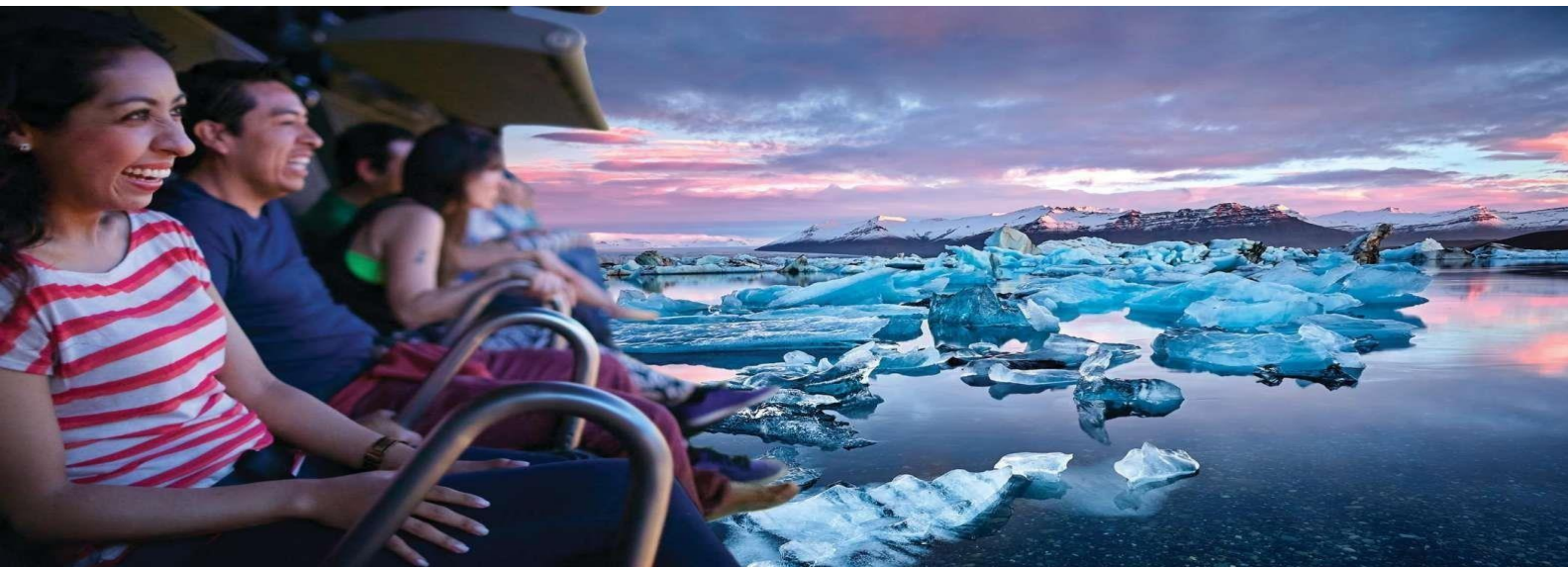


Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and stay overnight at Reykjavik.

DAY 9: REYKJAVIK – FLYOVER ICELAND – BLUE LAGOON – KEFLAVIK

BREAKFAST – INDIAN DINNER

After breakfast, check out from the hotel & enjoy FlyOver Iceland. FlyOver Iceland is a relatively new attraction in Reykjavík, located in the Grandi Harbour District. It is a ride that dangles you in front of a spherical screen taking you through Iceland’s most memorable landscapes taking in waterfalls, glaciers and volcanoes from above. You soar back and forth with the camera, giving you a sensation of flying. Special effects like mist as you



fly by waterfalls makes it an even more immersive experience.

Next, we will visit **Blue Lagoon**. The Blue Lagoon is a geothermal spa located in southwest Iceland in Reykjanes Peninsula, known for its bright blue waters and unique setting in a lava field. The lagoon is filled with mineral-rich water that is heated by the earth's natural geothermal activity and is known for its therapeutic properties.



In the late afternoon, indulge in some shopping at Reykjavik.

Later, have Indian dinner and check-in to the hotel followed by overnight stay in Keflavik.

DAY 10: REYKJAVIK – DELHI
